Biography eli shechtman was born in the shtetl of vas kovychi korestensky district near zhytomyr in the ukraine he was the seventh of eight children in his family he received traditional jewish education at a cheder eli s shechtman s mother died when he was eight years old and all the burden of care for the children fell on his father s shoulders
