Everyman s library was founded on 15th february 1906 with the publication by joseph dent 1849 1926 of fifty titles dent a master bookbinder turned publisher was a classic victorian autodidact the tenth child of a darlington house painter he had left school at thirteen and arrived in london with a half crown in his pocket
